#### Deck the Halls!

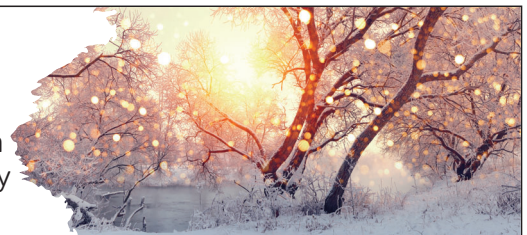
Let's decorate the walls of Pretend City with festive art! Children will work on their cutting and gluing skills as they create décor for both the museum and their homes.
