

# Field Trip Chaperone Guide

Thank you for being a chaperone! This leadership role is vital for a safe & fun learning experience.

### **Chaperone Ratio Requirement:**

Pretend City Children's Museum has the following ratio requirements:

Children 0-3 years: 1 Chaperone/ 3 Children Children 4-8 years: 1 Chaperone/ 5 Children Children 8+ years: 1 Chaperone/ 8 Children

If this ratio is not met, we will deny admittance. No refunds or exceptions will be made.

### **Chaperone Instructions:**

- Stay with your group at all times.
  Inadequately supervised groups or groups causing disturbances may be asked to leave.
- Review the community codes with your students and help them follow the codes.
- Accompany your students when visiting the Pretend City Mini-Mall.

## **Pretend City Community Codes**

Pretend City Children's Museum is a public space. All visitors deserve respect and the opportunity to enjoy the learning spaces in a fun and peaceful environment. If the community codes are not followed, your group may be asked to leave. No refunds or exceptions will be made.

- Grown-ups need to be accompanied by a child to enter Pretend City.
- Children need to be supervised by a grown-up.
- Pretend City encourages all visitors to play in peace.
- Pretend City is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Pretend City is a cell-phone free and electronics free facility.
- Enjoy your food and drinks only in the designated areas.
